Our selection of finger sandwiches this year will be:

- -Cream cheese with cucumber and dill
- -Cream cheese on raisin bread
- -Turkey with cranberry spread
- -Ham with brie spread
- -Egg salad

For those interested in making the cucumber sandwiches, here is the recipe for the spread:

8 ounces of cream cheese (brick or whipped tub)
Fresh dill, washed and blotted with paper towel
1 or 2 English cucumbers, washed then sliced thin (do not peel)

Thin white or wheat sandwich bread (Arnold or Pepperidge Farm)

Soften 8 ounces cream cheese. Cut up fresh dill. Add to cream cheese.

Cut crusts off the bread. (Make bread crumbs or croutons with them if you want)

Lay out a batch of slices on large cutting board. Spread a thin layer of cream cheese mixture on all slices of the sandwich bread.

Add sliced cucumber to half of the bread slices. Top with extra slices of bread.

Slice in thirds (bars) or quarters (triangles).

Place sandwiches in aluminum roasting pan.

Dampen paper towels with water and wring out best you can. Gently open the towels and place on top of the sandwiches. Cover pan with foil and seal TIGHTLY. These should be put together Saturday afternoon or Sunday morning.

For those interested in making the turkey sandwiches, here is the recipe for the spread:

1/2 cup cranberry sauce

1 1/2 Tablespoons grainy Dijon mustard

1 Tablespoon brown sugar

Mix well and spread on bread. MAKES 1/2 CUP
