



Understanding Gender Differences A Spanish teacher was explaining to her class that in Spanish, unlike English, nouns are designated as either masculine or feminine.

"House" for instance, is feminine: "la casa." "Pencil," however, is masculine: "el lapiz.'

4. As soon as you commit to one, you realize that if you had waited a little longer, you could have gotten a better model.
