### Legislation

Gov. Cuomo's 2019 budget includes his Abortion Expansion proposal. The bill S.7511-Budget/A.9511-Budget has many offensive parts: removing the 24 week & beyond ban on abortion; repeal the requirement that abortions be done by licensed physicians; allow third trimester abortions for any reason; remove safeguards for infants born alive (be accorded immediate legal protection; and eliminate all criminal penalties for abortions.

You can call 518-455-2800 and ask them to VOTE NO on the proposed budget if this proposal is not removed from consideration.
